

# Skills4Jersey customized training grants

## Do you offer grants to businesses to train their employees?

Yes, the Department of Labor and Workforce Development offers a grant program for businesses:

**Skills4Jersey** — training grants of up to \$1,000 per trainee to improve the skills of current employees or train new employees.

The grants, awarded competitively, are subject to funding caps per entity. They may be used for on-the-job or classroom training.

## Who can apply for these training grants?

- Individual businesses located in New Jersey
- A business organization, labor organization, or community organization

## Who can provide the training?

- A qualified employee of the business
- A training provider listed on the eligible training provider list ([njtopps.com/VendorFaqs.aspx](http://njtopps.com/VendorFaqs.aspx)), or
- A training provider approved by the Department of Labor and Workforce Development

## How can my company apply for a grant?
